

## Reporting an Issue with Google Street View.

Google StreetView is available through Google Maps and also Google Earth. Both systems will show the same image, but it is only through Google Maps that you can report an issue. ([www.maps.google.ie](http://www.maps.google.ie))

Where you have identified an image that you wish to report, you click on the “Report a Problem” link in the bottom left hand corner of the screen (see link highlighted in red).



When you click on this link, a new window is opened, which asks you to specify the issue with the image. For example, by clicking on “Privacy Concerns”, you are presented with further options, i.e face, house or car registration.

You are then asked to describe the problem and provide a contact e-mail address. You are then asked to highlight within the image the portion of the image where the issue exists. You must also enter a word verification and then click on submit.
