Data Controller

A person, company, or other body, which decides the purposes and means of processing personal data.

DPIA

Data Protection Impact Assessment - An assessment carried out by a data controller of the impact of envisaged processing operations on the protection of personal data where those processing operations are likely to result in a high risk to the rights and freedoms of natural persons.

Data Subject

A identifiable natural living person who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to their physical, genetic, mental, economic, economic or social identity.

DSAR

Data Subject Access Request - A request made by a data subject under Article 15 of the GDPR to obtain from a data controller access to their personal data.

EEA

European Economic Area - An area of free trade and free movement of peoples comprising the member states of the European Union, in addition to Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein.

GDPR

General Data Protection Regulation - Lays down rules relating to the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and rules relating to the free movement of personal data. A principled piece of legislation which allows organisations of different sizes, and with different objectives, to decide on and devise their own processes and procedures, to meet their respective objectives, once there is adherence to the basic principles as set out in data protection law.

Health Data

Personal data relating to the physical or mental health of a person, including the provisions of health care services.
